


GREECE GDP GROWTH RATE



GREEK BUDGET DEFICIT






Annual GDP Growth Adjusted by Inflation










CHINA UNEMPLOYMENT RATE


Annual GDP Growth Adjusted by Inflation









Real GDP growth rate in Japan (1956 - 2008)








Public debt (% of GDP)





# POPULATION OF JAPAN: 1880-2105






## VIETNAM GROWTH RATE OF GDP (% PER YEAR)
















**BRAZIL INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION**










**SOUTH AFRICA UNEMPLOYMENT RATE**






























BANGLADESH INFLATION RATE

Annual Change on Consumer Price Index









Exports (month-over-month)




AZERBAIJAN PERCENT CHANGE IN GDP AT CONSTANT PRICES




AZERBAIJAN INFLATION END-OF-PERIOD
